



PRESENT CONTINUOUS TENSE

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We use the present continuous tense, when we use "Am", "Is", or "Are" with a "...ing" Verb.

Example: I **am walking** home today.

Jack **is playing** football in the field.

Sarah **is sweeping** the floor.

The boys **are doing** their homework.



My mother **is cooking** chicken furry.

The children **are watching** television.

Bob **is doing** his homework on the computer.

Note: Remember always using Verb - ing.

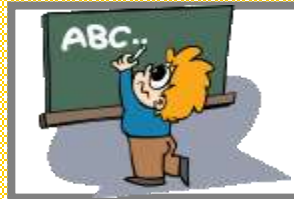

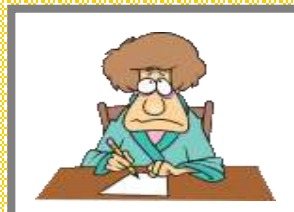
