

## PRESENT CONTINUOUS TENSE

(Answers)

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We use the present continuous tense, when we use "Am", "Is", or "Are" with a "...ing" Verb.

Example: I am walking home today.

Jack is playing football in the field.

Sarah is sweeping the floor.

The boys are doing their homework.



My mother is cooking chicken furry.
The children are watching television.
Bob is doing his homework on the computer.
Note: Remember always using Verb – ing.
He, she, it – is You, we, they – are




